



## **CLUB RESPECT FOR LAW / NON-VIOLENCE COMMITTEE**

**PURPOSE:** To provide the community a focus against local violence issues, particularly those involving children and families, to recognize youth who assist law enforcement and recognize local law enforcement officials in the community. To include children and youth as awardees or as program participants in all Respect for Law activities.

**PERSONNEL:** The Committee should consist of 1-6 members including the Chair. Committee members should be willing to organize programs with public information access.

### **DUTIES/RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- To plan new, and continue developing existing Respect for Law / Non-Violence Programs annually for the Club.
- Cooperate, where possible and appropriate, with the local Bar Association's observance of Law Day, promoting the inclusion of the education of children in our freedoms protected by independent courts and the bill of rights.

**ACTION PLANS:** Plan, promote and conduct a Respect for Law / Non-Violence Programs activity that will inspire respect for law and extol the virtue of non-violence toward the youth of the community.
